The most recent data from the Australian Institute of Health and Welfare showed that 17% of children are overweight, and 7,7% are obese. This means that nearly 1 in 4 children has an increased risk of physical health issues, increased chances of illness and morality in adulthood .

For restaurant owners, food growers and the retail marketers , the rise of social media has influenced what food they sell, how they sell it and even what they should do next. Before Instagram , charging 10 £ for a sandwich in London was a daylight robbery ; however , now with the help of social media, it is a commonly accepted price to pay.

A/COMPREHENSION 8pts

Read the text carefully to do the following activities.

(15pts)

NASA's DAVINCI mission, named after the artist and scientist *Leonardo Davinci*, is scheduled to launch in the late 2020s, probably in June 2029. The mission will study the origin, evolution, and present state of Venus in unprecedented detail. The mission's goal is to help answer longstanding questions about our neighboring planet, especially whether Venus was ever wet and habitable like Earth.

The DAVINCI spacecraft will carry an atmospheric descent probe which is a scientific instrument carried by spacecraft that separates and falls into the atmosphere of a planet until reaching its surface. After exploring the upper of Venus's atmosphere, the spacecraft will drop its probe to the surface. Made of titanium, one of the world's strongest metals, the spherical probe is about 1 meter, wide and will be built to withstand the extreme environment on Venus. On its one hour-long descent trip, the probe will take thousands of measurements and snap up-close images of the surface as soon as it emerges below the clouds, since the probe may not survive landing.

Ultimately, DAVINCI mission shows the ongoing pursuit to understand the universe. It not only represents a scientific endeavor but also a testament to human curiosity and ingenuity.
